The Mountain Brook Metropolitan District has adopted budgets for one fund, a General Fund to provide for operating and maintenance expenditures.

The District's accountants have utilized the modified accrual basis of accounting and the budget has been adopted after proper postings, publications and public hearing.

The primary sources of revenue for the District in 2021 will be property taxes and developer advances. The District intends to impose a 50.000 mill levy on property within the District for 2021, all of which is dedicated to the General Fund.
